



Use this database to find:

1. People in the census from any state, prior to 1931
2. Birth, marriage, and death records (some states and countries)
3. Immigration records and some records from other countries

How to get there:

- Go to SJCPL's Local & Family History website (www.libraryforlife.org/localhistory)
- Click on **Digital collections and databases**
- Click on **Ancestry Library Edition**
- **Note:** This database is only available in library branches
- Basic search, or for more options, choose "Show Advanced"

To see results:

1. Click on "View Summarized by category" or click on a category under "Narrow by category"
2. In the resulting lists, click on any databases that look promising

To do an Advanced search:

- Type the first and last name of a person, choose "Match all terms exactly," and choose "Soundex matches" in the "Restrict to exact" pull-down menu
- Close the pull-down menu & enter a state or country in the location box (hidden under the pull-down in the diagram shown above right)
- Click on **Search**

Ancestry answers questions like:

1. I'd like to find out when my great-grandmother died.
2. What country did my family come from?
3. What unit did my ancestor serve in during the Civil War?
